
## **INFORMATION MEETING 2023**

The Tertiary Education Scholarships Scheme (TESS) is intended to support good quality tertiary education at MQF Level 7 and MQF Level 8, aiming to contribute towards the Maltese labour market with the highly skilled individuals.

The scheme is aimed to support those pursuing this path to succeed both at the level of education attainment as well as contributing effectively towards the economy.

### **APPLICATION PROCESS**


- Regulations will be accessible through the website: <u>https://education.gov.mt/myscholarships/</u>
- It is important to read through the regulations before applying.
- An online application will be available and accessible through the same website.

# E-ID

To apply, one needs to have a valid E-ID, and:

- Be a Maltese Citizen
- Be a national of an EU/EEA state and have permanent residence in Malta and have been residing in Malta for the past five years
- Be a third country national that has been living in Malta for the past five years and has been granted long-term residence for the past five years

\*All information is found in regulations.





### **APPLICATION**

Documentation will need to be submitted including:

- Three Appendixes
- Work and Education Form
- Residence Permit (If Applicable)
- Disability Card (If Applicable)
- Unconditional Letter of Acceptance
- Transcripts
- MQRIC evaluation statements (If Applicable)

#### **DEADLINES FOR DOCUMENTS:**

- The deadline for the Application, Three Appendixes, Template of Employment, Disability Card\* & Residence Permit\* is the **28th June 2023 by Noon.** These documents need to be uploaded with the application on the website. Any transcript or MQRIC statement already in hand can also be uploaded with the application.
- The deadline for the Transcripts, Unconditional Letter of Acceptance and MQRIC reports is the 6th of October 2023 by 4PM. These need to be sent via e-mail on tess.meyr@gov.mt.
- \*The Disability Card and Residence Permit should only be uploaded if applicable \*Do not upload ID cards with the application.



- We **strongly recommend** that you do not leave applying for the last few days.
- Applications submitted after the deadline of the 28th June 2023 will not be accepted, and missing mandatory documents may lead to the application becoming ineligible.



**O1** The Scholarship is launched, and the application is opened. The regulations are posted on the website.

Applicants who apply, submit all required documents by the **1st Deadline** and fall under the eligibility criteria by the **28th June 2023** are called for an interview with the board. Interviews will take place between July and September 2023. Applicants will need prepare a presentation for the interview



After the interviews, there is a **2nd deadline** for documentation which is the **6th of October 2023.** After this deadline and an external process, rankings will be posted. A number of applicants will be awarded a scholarship.





### Important Information

- Rankings can only be published after
  the 2nd Deadline which is the 6th of
  October 2023 and an external process.
  - The Scholarship is very competitive, and therefore even if you are ranked, it does not mean you are awarded the Scholarship. The number of awardees depends on the budget.
- Once the rankings are published, applicants will be notified via e-mail and the rankings will be posted on the website.

### POWERPOINT PRESENTATION

A PowerPoint Presentation will need to be prepared for the TESS board interview which will focus on the appendixes. Further information will be given before the interview (This does not need to be uploaded with the application)



### WORK AND EDUCATION FORM

A Work and Education Form can be found annexed to the regulations for applicants to fill in and will also be posted on the website under the TESS Scholarship Scheme section. The content reflected in the work and Education template will prevail for the purpose of the interview and mark allocation



# UNCONDITIONAL LETTER OF ACCEPTANCE (ULA)

- A statement by the Recognized Educational Institution that it is unconditionally accepting the Applicant
- The Commencement Date of studies.
- The End Date of studies.
- The Modality of study (distance learning, part time, blended or full-time studies).
- The Number of Credits / Number of ECTSs
- The Number of obligatory visits on University campus
- The Tuition Fee for the entire course duration.
- The Bench Fees (if applicable)
- A Statement as to whether the applicant is receiving wavering of fees or bursary from the Recognised Educational Institution
- Any other information required by the Scholarships Unit.

Further information can be found on clause 4.1.17 on the regulations, it is important to read the regulations.

## All this information is obligatory and needs to be listed in the ULA.



### IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT THE ULA



 The ULA needs to be sent directly by the Recognized Institute to the TESS e-mail, for verification purposes. ULA's forwarded to the TESS by the applicant or uploaded with the application will not be accepted.



• Only the Tuition Fees/ Bench Fees listed in the ULA sent by the deadline of the 6th October 2023 will be funded. Therefore, it is important to make sure all fees are listed.



• The number of obligatory visits abroad on campus per year for students studying part time/distance learning/ blended learning also need to be listed on the ULA, otherwise they will not be funded.



### TRANSCRIPTS

- Only Official Detailed Academic Transcripts are accepted. Screenshots from websites or unofficial transcripts will not be considered for marking purposes.
- Academic Marks are only given on the highest qualifications (From MQF Level 5 upwards). Therefore, only send in the transcript for the highest qualification.
- If Transcripts are already in hand, they can be uploaded with the application.

### **MQRIC REPORTS**

(Retrieved from the Malta Further & Higher Education Authority- MFHEA)

- A MQRIC report will need to be sent in for Transcripts of Qualifications of MQF Level 5 or higher not found on the 'List of Accredited Courses' on the MFHEA website. Only send in the MQRIC report of the highest qualification. (Clause 4.1.11)
- A MQRIC report will also need to be sent in for Courses with Institutes not featured in the 'List of Accredited Courses offered by Licensed Institutions'. (Clause 5.2).

Excluding qualifications/courses with University of Malta, MCAST and ITS.



### TESS FUNDING

Applicants may apply to read for full-time or part-time/ blended/ distance learning programmes with any Educational Institution (In Malta and Abroad) as long as the institutions mentioned on the application are recognized and the programmes chosen are accredited.





Learning programs need to be at level 7 ( Post Graduate Certificate Diploma/Masters) or Level 8 (PhD) The Tess reimburses Tuition fees and Bench fees, and also offers a Study Abroad & Visit Allowance, & Disability Allowance

### FUNDING FOR TUTION FEES/BENCH FEES




Up to €32,000 reimbursed in Tuition Fees and Bench fees ( Only fees listed on the ULA will be reimbursed)

- Maximum duration for full time (5 years)
- Maximum duration for part time (7 years)

Up to €10,000 reimbursed in Tuition fees and Bench fees (Only fees listed on the ULA will be reimbursed)

- Maximum duration for full time (4 years)
- Maximum duration for part time (5 years)

### FURTHER ALLOWANCES



### STUDY ABROAD ALLOWANCE

- Up to 4000 euro per annum for full time studies abroad on campus ( on presentation of boarding passes & confirmation from university)
- 200 euro per visit to foreign educational institutes for part time/distance learning/blended courses ( up to a maximum of 2400 euros per year).
- All visits need to be listed on the ULA.

### **DISABILITY ALLOWANCE**


• 2000 euro per annum on presentation of a disability card.

### **OTHER INFORMATION**



- Applicants who have a Level 7 master's degree may apply for another master's degree, BUT they are not allowed to apply for programs of studies below master's degree, Applicants already in possession of an MQF Level 8 qualification cannot apply.
- TESS reimburses the tuition fees for the entire course duration, even if the course has already started, as long as the course is ending throughout or beyond 2024, and the fees are listed on the ULA.
- The TESS administration needs to be informed if any other grants/scholarships have been awarded for the same course. Double funding is not allowed.
