






► ONLINE APPLICATION

- Fill in the correct details
- Application allows you to complete it at a later stage
- Avoid changing your e-mail address
- Inform us via e-mail with any changes/mistakes
- Apply as early as possible to avoid disappointments
- Late applications will not be considered
- Choose one Priority Area (avoid choosing 'Other')









INELIGIBILITY

- ESF project with programming period ending in 2023.
- Start date of course must not be before 14th June 2021.
- Start date of course must not be after 31st December 2021.
- ▶ End date of course must not be after 30th September 2023.
- Those already in possession of a Masters degree may apply but cannot apply for a lower level ex. PG Cert./PG Dip.
- Those already in possession of a Leve 8 degree cannot apply
- ▶ ULA, MQRIC reports, transcripts/certificates and documents related with the allowances are to reach the office by not later than 8th October 2021

- You gain marks for work experience. Input clearly job descriptions and period of employment/voluntary work on CV










► UNCONDITIONAL LETTER OF ACCEPTANCE

- ▶ ULA as per Clause 3.29 (if awarded the agreement will be based on ULA provided by University)
- Unconditional
- Title of Course
- Exact start and End dates (ex. 4th September 2021 6th September 2022)
- ECTS or the equivalent
- Mode of study (ex. Full time/Part time/Distance Learning)
- Number of obligatory visits (applicable for part time/DL)
- Must reach the office by 8th October 2021 (4.00 p.m)
- Inform your university to e-mail us the required details above









- MQRIC Recognition Statement/receipt of MQRIC statement

- For qualifications obtained from foreign universities/institutions. Marks are not given if this does not reach the office by 8th October 2021 (4.00 p.m)
- For the course applying for if it is carried out in a foreign university/institution (ineligible if this document does not reach the office by 8th October 2021 (4.00 p.m)
- Receipts issued by MQRIC office, are temporary accepted till 8th October 2021 until the actual report is issued.

Where the prospective qualification is issued by a foreign university/institution:

Awardees shall be entitled for the first 30% of the amount as follows:

No. of ECTS	Full Entitlement (€100 per each ECTS)	30% (1 st payment) after signing of Agreement
60 ECTS	€ 6,000	€1,800
90 ECTS	€ 9,000	€2,700
120 ECTS	€12,000	€3,600







Type of Allowance – Section 12	
Study Abroad Allowance	For visits of one month or more, the allowances will be calculated pro-rata (€2,500).
KEEP BOARDING PASSES	For visits of less than one month, the €200 per visit will apply.
Children Allowance for children under 16yrs	€1,170 p.a. for 1 st Child and €700 p.a. for any other child
Gozo Allowance	€1,050 p.a.
CRPD Holders	€2,000 p.a.











PAYMENTS

- The office will issue Claim Forms with payment details
- After the 1st payment (30%), the interim payments will be processed upon confirmation from the university that the 30% are achieved and exceeded
- Consequent claim forms are issued when the office is in receipt of confirmation from university that another number of ECTS's have been achieved

- Online Interviews: August September 2021
- Documentation: 8th October 2021 (4.00 p.m)
- Issuing ineligible letters: October/November 2021

- Signing of Agreements: Expected December February 2022
- Processing payments: Expected February 2022
