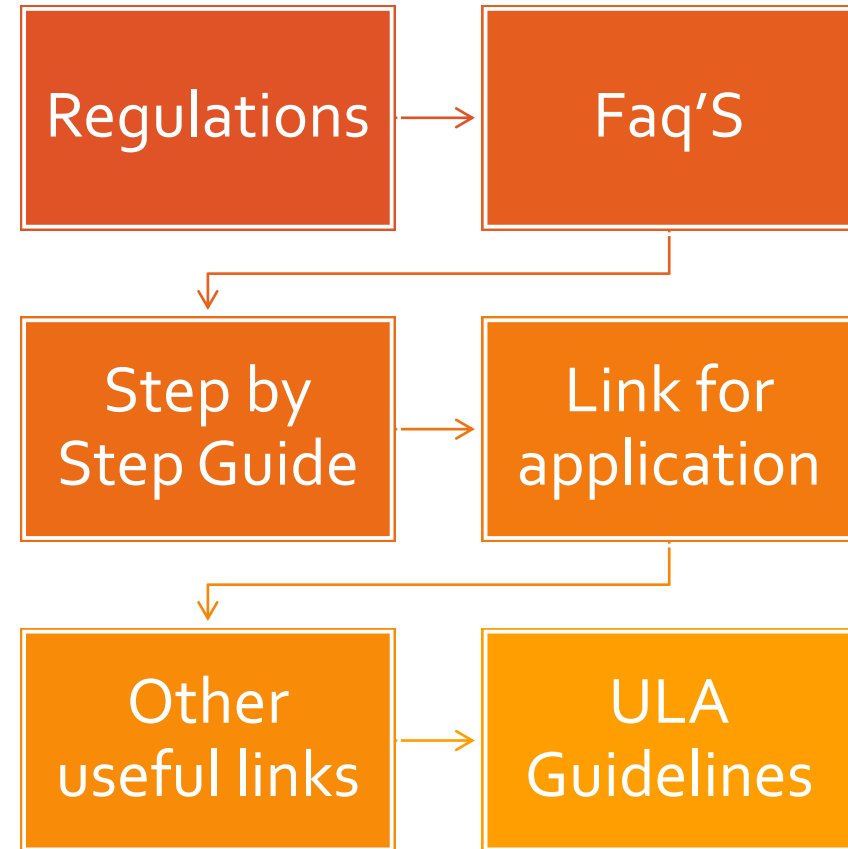

## AVOID BREACHING THE REGULATIONS



- Submit a correct application
- Late applications will not be considered. The system shuts off automatically.
- Uploading the right documentation.
- Start date of course must not be before 20<sup>th</sup> June 2022.
- Start date of course must not be after 30<sup>th</sup> June 2023.
- Cannot opt for a university which is not listed on your application.
- Those already in possession of a Masters degree may apply but cannot apply for a lower level ex. PG Cert./PG Dip.
- Those already in possession of a Level 8 degree cannot apply
- ULA, MQRIC reports and transcripts/certificates are to reach the office by not later than Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> October 2022.
- Recommended to go also through the other schemes and attend the online meetings

	Part-Time/Distance/Blended	
	Joint full time programmes where one of the institutions is in Malta and the other is a recognized foreign institution	For visits of less than one month, then the €200 per visit will apply up to not more than €2400 per annum
Persons with Disability	Part-Time/Distance/Blended Fulltime/Part-Time/Distance/Blended	€2,000 p.a.

After the 1<sup>st</sup> payment (30%), the interim payments will be processed upon confirmation from the university that the 30% are achieved and exceeded

Consequent claim forms are issued when the office is in receipt of confirmation from university that another number of ECTS's have been achieved
