



Guidelines for the online application.

Before applying one requires the following forms available from our website:

Consent form (for minors under 18 years)

1. Parents/guardians are to fill in their names and ID Card NO and underline what applies to them.
2. Fill in the required information.

Fill in the rest of the document with the required information.

The Data Protection Form

Parents/Guardians of minors are required to fill in the minor's details in the top part of the form and parent/guardian is required to sign the bottom part.

TRS9 Form

This form is required to credit the grant amount to your bank account therefore please make sure to fill in the details correctly as follows: -

Bank account holder is to fill in name and surname under the Business Name

Trading Name can be left blank

Fill in Home Address

Include ID Card number instead of VAT registration number

Contact person may be left blank.

The applicant is to fill in their email and phone/mobile number.

Make sure to have the required documents before applying:

- Invoices/receipts/bank statements for both the programme fee and accommodation
- Flight tickets and Boarding Pass
- Certificate of Attendance


