Who can apply?

Those who will be following a recognised course at:

MQF Level 7 on Full Time, Part-Time, Distance Learning or Blended;

4.01.1 Applicants shall start their course leading to Qualification at MQF Level 7 between **27 th April 2026** and **26th April 2027**. Applicants who have already started the course before **27th April 2026** are not eligible to apply.

4.01.2 The end date of programmes must be by or before **15th October 2029**



Boards and Audits

- Endeavour II Board – oversees the scheme and selection. During the interviews there will be a minimum of three members.
- Appeals Board – is an autonomous board – Deals with appeals letters.
- Audits are carried out at various stages of the process.

- Late applications will not be considered. The system shuts off automatically.
- Upload the right documentation.
- Start date of course must not be before 27th April 2026.
- Start date of course must not be after 26th April 2027.
- Only universities listed on application will be considered.
- Those already in possession of a Masters degree may apply but cannot apply for a lower level ex. PG Cert./PG Dip.
- Those already in possession of a MQF Level 8 degree cannot apply

The Assistance Allowance is given to awardees who were found eligible for Supplementary Allowances in 2025 by the Student Maintenance Grants Board MEYR for studies at MQF Level 6 or receiving the Additional Cost of Living Benefit from the Ministry for Social Policy and Children's Rights for year 2026, and where the income level of the Household and the applicant is below 60% of the national median equivalised disposable income. In the instance, where the applicant is the Head of Household, the household's equivalised income threshold shall apply. Scholarship Awardees who will be confirmed eligible for the Scholarships Grant by the Endeavour II Board/Office will benefit from an additional allowance of two thousand euro (€2,000) per annum. An awardee may only benefit from one assistance allowance.

	Joint full time programmes where one of the institutions is in Malta and the other is a recognized foreign institution Part-Time/Distance/Blended	For visits less than 30 days, then the €200 per visit will apply up to not more than €2400 per annum

Assistance Allowance	Full time/Part-Time/Distance/Blended	€2,000 p.a.

After the signing of agreement, the 1st claim form will be issued covering the 50% upfront of the grant.

After the 1st payment (50% of the total ECTS), the interim payments will be processed upon receipt from the university that the initial 50% paid for, are achieved and exceeded

Consequent claim forms are issued when the office is in receipt of interim reports from university that another number of ECTS has been achieved. The report must include code and title of module and related ECTS.

Reimbursed in the awardee's account as quoted on their Financial Identification Form.
